Connecting with the last lesson you can say the nationality for any country like how we learnt, some countries which start with (Al- ) We drop it then we put ( ey) at the end for masculine or (eyyah) for feminine :

Al- Kuwayt → Kuaytey, Kuaytey Kuayteyyah Kuayteyyah

Let's do it with another example:

Al-3iraaq → 3iraaqey 3iraaqey 3iraaqeyyah 3iraaqeyyah

Some countries ends with ( aa) we drop it then we put ( ey) at the end for masculine or (eyyah) for feminine:

Amreekaa → Amreekey Amreekey Amreekeyyah Amreekeyyah

Let's do it with another example:

Faransaa → Faranseyy Faranseyy Faranseyyah Faranseyyah

Some countries ends with ( yaa) we drop it then we put ( ey) at the end for masculine or (eyyah) for feminine:

Breetaanyaa → Breetaaney Breetaaney, Breetaaneyyah Breetaaneyyah

Let's do it with another example:

Almaanyaa → Almaaney Almaaney, Almaaneyyah Almaaneyyah

Some countries starts with ( a) then double ss or rr (any consonant) we drop (a) with one consonent then we put ( ey) at the end for masculine or (eyyah) for feminine, but you should see if the word has (yaa) or (aa) at the end also drop it:

Do you remember Assuoodeyyah?

Assuoodaan → suoodey suoodey, suoodeyyah suoodeyyah

Let's do it with another example:

Assoodaan → soodaaney soodaaney ,soodaaneyyah soodaaneyyah

Wow, you did it, now you know a lot of countries and cities and how to change the name of the country to nationality in Arabic.
