There are many ways to congratulate others on the holidays, the most famous

one is: Koll 3aam wa anta bekhair كُلَّ عَامٍ وَأَنْتَ بِخَيْرٍ (Masculine singular)

Koll 3aam wa ante bekhair كُلَّ عَامٍ وَأَنْتِ بِخَيْرٍ (Feminine singular)

Koll 3aam wa antoma bekhair كُلَّ عَامٍ وَأَنْتُمَا بِخَيْرٍ (Masculine/Feminine dual)

Koll 3aam wa antom bekhair كُلَّ عَامٍ وَأَنْتُمْ بِخَيْرٍ (Masculine or Mix plural)

Koll 3aam wa antonna bekhair كُلَّ عَامٍ وَأَنْتُنَّ بِخَيْرٍ (Feminine plural)

So, you must be careful which one you will use it with Masculine singular ,

Feminine singular, Masculine or Mix plural, or Feminine plural.

As you see the deference between them is in on one word, this word is the pronoun, that's means:

“ anta” = you Masculine singular

“ ante” = you Feminine singular

“antoma”= you Masculine/Feminine dual

“antom” = You Masculine plural

“antonna” = you Feminine plural
